

Commas

Rule 1. use a comma and a coordinating conjunction (FANBOY) to join two simple sentences. For and Nor But Or Yet

Rule 2. use a single comma to include that a word or words have been omitted, or to avoid a possible miss-reading

- use a comma to separate three or more items in a series
- use commas to separate two or more adjectives preceding a noun
- use a single comma to avoid missreading
