

Bible, Chapter 21, Lesson Review

- Jesus said He would send the Helper, or the Counselor—the Spirit of truth, God the Holy Spirit—from the Father.
 - Enlighten means to give knowledge and understanding to.
 - The Holy Spirit gives wisdom and enlightens the understanding of believers by helping them understand the deep truths in God's Word. Empower means to give power to.
- The power of the Holy Spirit enlightens and empowers Christians with the same power God used to raise Jesus Christ from the dead.
- A key reason that Christians should not worry or be afraid is that the Holy Spirit helps and comforts them.
- . God equips believers with a spirit of power, of love, and of a sound mind or self-discipline.
- The Holy Spirit empowers believers to live a godly life and to do God's will.
 - The Holy Spirit empowers believers with leadership and boldness to share God's Word and the gospel of Jesus Christ.
 - The Holy Spirit empowered Peter to become a leader in the early Church
 - Paul said he was not ashamed of the gospel because it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes. The reason the gospel is God's saving power is because it reveals who God truly is and faith in God through Jesus removes separation from Him.
- Stephen, full of the Holy Spirit, saw the glory of God while men threw stones at him until he died.
- The message of the cross is the power of God to those who are being saved. When a person hears the truth about God and the salvation through Jesus that He offers, the powerful message shows them how not to be separated from Him anymore.
 - The Holy Spirit empowers Christians to obey Jesus' command to share the gospel. This command is called the Great Commission
