- Believers are the salt of the earth, meaning people who help preserve good in the world.
- Salt adds flavor. Christians can season their part of the earth with obedience to God, with godliness, and with the fruit of the Spirit.
- Salt is a necessary ingredient for life. Christians have the message of eternal life through Christ, who takes away the world's sin.
- Salt makes people thirsty. When others see Jesus in believers, they may become thirsty for the things of God.
- Christians are most useful to God when they are pure in heart, mind, and deed.
- Jesus Christ says that He is the Light of the World.
- Jesus says that His followers are also the light of the world, meaning people who spread the good news of Jesus.
- Jesus taught that believers should be filled with His light and should have no darkness in them.
- Christians can let their light shine through their actions and words.
- Christians should walk, or live, as children of light by doing good things, acting in right ways, being truthful with others, and living in a way that pleases the Lord.
- Christians should sow, or plant, the seeds of the gospel and reap, or pick, the fruit by sharing the gospel with others and helping them accept Jesus.
- The Bible instructs Christians to go and share the gospel.
