

## Lesson 24 Review

Review the Bible truths from this lesson by covering the following:

- Five aspects of prayer are praise, confession and repentance, thanksgiving, others' needs, and personal needs.
- Christians should praise and thank God for how great He is.
  - . Christians can bring their own cares, physical needs, and spiritual needs to the Lord in prayer.
- Jesus taught His disciples to pray using a model prayer. Jesus' model prayer is frequently called the Lord's Prayer.
- The Lord's Prayer contains statements and petitions. A petition is a request. God invites His children to bring their requests to Him.
- In the Lord's Prayer, the word hallowed means holy. When Christians say the Lord's Prayer, they are saying that God the Father is holy. Because Christians request God's forgiveness, they have the responsibility to forgive those who have sinned against them.
- Prayer should be the first priority of a believer who is faced with a problem, not a last step after he or she has tried every other solution. Christians should pray boldly and in faith. Christians ought to seek God's kingdom and His will first in all their prayers.
- Prayer for others' needs is called intercession.
- The Church often intercedes in prayer for Christians who have physical or spiritual needs.
- Christians in the early Church agreed in prayer for Peter's release from prison. God answered their prayer and sent an angel to rescue Peter.
- God answers prayers in different ways.
  - . God will say no to a prayer if it is not in accordance with His will.
- Sometimes Christians need to keep praying, listening to God through His Word and in prayer, and waiting in faith for God's answer to their prayers.
- The Holy Spirit intercedes for Christians by praying on their behalf when they do not know how or what to pray.
- Believers will not always know why God answers as He does, but they should continue to pray to Him in faith.
