

New families must provide a final report card from the current school showing pass/fail for the student that is being enrolled before that student can begin school.

FBCS follows the guidelines set forth by the state for pass/fail. Parents need to be aware that if a student has not been promoted into the grade for which the student has been registered, FBCS may not be able to accommodate them in the retained grade level due to space availability.

Non-refundable fees will not be reimbursed if that situation occurs.

All students enrolling at FBCS are enrolled on a probationary status. If the Administrator deems the students attendance, behavior or academics are detrimental to the school's overall performance and the issues are not being resolved the student will be asked to withdraw from FBCS and no refunds of monies paid will be refunded.

## **ADMISSIONS CRITERIA**

- A.** First Baptist Christian School does not discriminate on the basis of race, sex, color, or ethnic origin in the administration of its educational, admission and other school administered programs.
- B.** The specific procedure for "Returning" and "New" student admissions is outlined in the enrollment packet that can be found on the website.
- C.** A student will not be re-admitted if there is an outstanding tuition balance from the previous year.
- D.** *Entrance testing requirements:* Administration will review previous school records of all new students, 1-12, to determine if tests are needed to finalize placement in FBCS.
- E.** *Age requirements:* 1st grade students must be 6 years old before October 1<sup>st</sup>; seniors cannot exceed the age of 19 by October 1st of their senior year.
- F.** Regarding admission of any student who has been expelled from another St. Tammany Parish system, FBCS would follow the same guidelines as the parish system; however, if the family is a member at First Baptist Church, then the student's admission would be considered by the school committee.
- G.** In order for a student to be admitted to FBCS, the student and his/her family must be willing to adopt a code of Christian conduct, grounded in the school's statement of faith and abide by those parameters for acceptable behavior.

## First Baptist Christian School Acceptable Use Policy (AUP) 1<sup>st</sup> - 6<sup>th</sup> grade

The First Baptist Christian School Acceptable Use Policy applies to all technology resources including, but not limited to: personal laptop computers, school computers or iPads, cell phones, video and audio equipment, copy machines and information storage devices. First Baptist Christian School students are expected to use school resources in a considerate, ethical, moral and legal manner.

All First Baptist Christian School technology systems and information stored on them are governed by school policies and are subject to school supervision and inspection whether they reside on school owned computers or computers or external drives brought on campus by students. First Baptist Christian School reserves the right to monitor, access, retrieve, read and disclose all messages, information, and files created, sent, posted from, stored on laptops brought onto campus, or stored on its systems to law enforcement officials or others without prior notice. Any student who violates this policy or any applicable local, state or federal laws is subject to disciplinary action, a loss of technology privileges, and may face legal prosecution.

**Electronic Devices;** The privacy of all students is protected during the school day.. Personal items that can take and/or transmit electronic images including digital cameras, cell phones and video cameras cannot be used to take or transmit images at any time during the school day unless approved by the Administration. The school reserves the right to confiscate and review information on any electronic device from students who violate this rule, and students will be called to the office if this rule is broken.

### Acceptable Use on FBCS Computers, iPads and General Computer Use

First Baptist Christian School provides computer access to students who use the access in accordance with the mission and philosophy of First Baptist Christian School. Students agree to the following terms as a condition of having computer/internet access:

1. **Appropriate Use:** Student use of the First Baptist Christian School computers must be consistent with the philosophy of First Baptist Christian School and its educational goals. Misuse includes any Internet conduct on or off-campus that negatively affects the reputation of First Baptist Christian School including messages sent, posted or received that suggest harassment, racism, sexism and inappropriate language or symbols.
2. **Vandalism/Hacking:** Students will not use their First Baptist access or other Internet access to interfere with or disrupt network users, services, First Baptist Christian School data or data of another student, or equipment, either locally or off campus.
3. **Unauthorized Entry:** Students will not access or try to make unauthorized entry to any machine accessible via the network or on remote networks. If a student notices a security problem, the student must notify school personnel immediately.
4. **Inappropriate Messages:** Students will not use their First Baptist access to transmit threatening, obscene or harassing materials, including chain-letters, solicitations, inappropriate photos, or broadcast messages via our network or email system.
5. **Inappropriate Material:** The Internet contains certain material that is illegal, defamatory, inaccurate or potentially offensive to some people. Students will not use their First Baptist access to knowingly visit sites that contain this material nor import, transmit and/or transfer any of this material to other computers.
6. **School Personnel:** Students should not email, post to websites or blogs, images, photos or video of employees of First Baptist Christian School. This includes the creation of fan pages or groups on social networking sites.
7. **Private Use:** Students will not provide their First Baptist access or password or share another student's password with any other student or non-student. Students may not use another individual's account or log onto the Internet as anyone else.
8. **Personal Privacy:** Students will not communicate their address, phone number or other personal information to any person or company on the Internet or through email.
9. **Unauthorized Programs or Computers:** Students may not use, copy, delete, or install any program on a school computer or save any executable program without the permission of school personnel. Students may not use personal laptop computers without prior permission from the Administration.
10. **Copyright:** Students are not to post to websites or blogs any photos or logos that are the property (intellectual property) of First Baptist Christian School.

Any unauthorized technology used for the purpose of bypassing security systems, including internet filtering is not permitted. This included the use of ssh, proxy-bypass software, remote desktop sessions, anonymizing websites/software and other technologies.

Any costs, charges, liabilities or damage by misuse of the computers are the individual student's responsibility. Any consequences of service interruption or privacy violation, will lead to disciplinary action. Such action can include suspension and/or expulsion from First Baptist Christian School.
